

# WARNING - risk of burning!

- ⇒ The barbecue must be positioned on a stable and secure surface when it is in use, otherwise it may tip over.
- ⇒ **WARNING!** This barbecue becomes very hot and should not be moved while in use!
- ⇒ Wear barbecue mitts or use barbecue tongs when barbecuing.
- ⇒ Allow the barbecue to cool down completely before cleaning it.
- AUTION! Do not use spirit or petrol to light or re-light the fire!

- AUTION! Only use firelighters that correspond to the European Standard for firelighters (EN 1860-3)!
- ⇒ Never use water to extinguish the charcoal.



#### WARNING - risk of suffocation!

⇒ Do not use indoors!



#### **DANGER to children and pets!**

- ⇒ Never leave the hot barbecue unattended.
- ARNING! Keep children and pets at a safe distance!

# Safe Operation of the Barbecue

Before using the barbecue for the first time, it should be heated with fuel (charcoal or briquette) for approximately 30 minutes.

#### General hints for a successful assembly

Carefully read the assembly instructions and the listed safety hints. Take time to assemble the barbecue and allow for a free area of approximately two - three square metres. Remove the barbecue from the packaging!

Note: First assemble all parts loosely, upon completion tighten all nuts and bolts securely

### **Preparation**

Check that all parts are complete as per the list and drawing. Have suitable tools ready.
